January 9, 2025	If School Board decides to move forward with the Petition/Remonstrance Race: School Corporation publishes Notice of Applicability of Petition/Remonstrance Process for the projects	BC drafts; SC delivers	
February 10, 2025	First business day to pick up Petition/Remonstrance forms and begin circulating	County Clerk	
March 12, 2025	End of Petition/Remonstrance Race		
April 2, 2025	County Clerk and Auditor count valid taxpayer/voter signatures on petitions (Assumes 3 weeks to complete)	County	

If School Corporation wins petition-remonstrance race: Move forward with the Project
